The House of Germany is a non-profit, cultural organization, affiliated with the House of Pacific Relations in Balboa Park, whose purpose is to inform the general public about the music, traditions, history, and the culture of Germany. While most people join because they, their spouse or their ancestors were born in Germany, membership application is open to any person who wishes to learn about Germany or the German culture.

Located in beautiful Balboa Park in San Diego, California, the House of Germany is one of the International Cottages within the House of Pacific Relations which has members representing 33 countries or ethnic groups. The goal of the Houses is to further the pursuit of "pacific" or peaceful relations among nations. The House of Germany was founded in 1935 and to this day has a very active membership, long standing traditions and maintains strong ties to Germany. Members welcome guests to the **House of Germany Cottage** every Saturday and Sunday from 11 AM to 4 PM and serve refreshments. Members are obligated to serve as hosts at least one Saturday or Sunday each year. Special events are held during the year, including our **Springfest** and luncheon, the **Lawn Program** each spring or summer, **Ethnic Food Festival**, and the **International Christmas Festival** which celebrates the holiday season.

Membership: Persons aged 18 years or older are welcome to become members. Children under the age of 18 automatically become members when a parent becomes a member. To become a new member and receive the bimonthly newsletter please fill out the Membership Application available on our website (see above) and send with payment to the Membership Secretary as explained on the application.

Members are encouraged to attend **membership meetings** to share their ideas and suggestions concerning the House of Germany and its activities. Meetings are scheduled for the **first Sunday of odd months** in the House of Germany at 4:30 PM. All members are expected to **host in the House of Germany cottage** at least once per year on Saturdays or Sundays between 11 AM - 4 PM when the cottage is open to the public.
